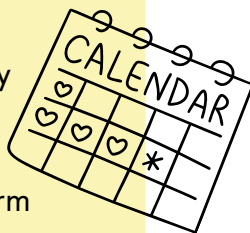
Well done to:

SCHOOL UNIFORM



Please ensure that children follow our school uniform policy at all times. Trainers may be worn on PE days only, and joggers, sweatshirts, and hoodies should be plain. Cycling shorts may be worn; however, please ensure they are of an appropriate length and provide full coverage.
