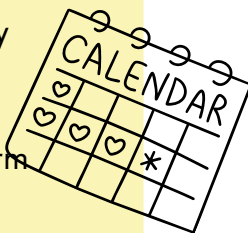
Well done to:

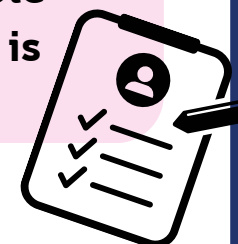


ATTENDANCE
