Happy New Year to everyone, and a very warm welcome back! Despite a tricky start to the week with the weather, the children have quickly settled back into their routines.

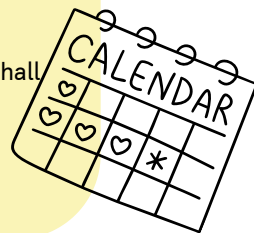
