


Next week we are looking forward to celebrating Science Week.

IMPORTANT SAFETY NOTICE

We have been informed of a serious incident which took place at the weekend, involving children from school. A group of children were playing by the Dane and one child fell in the water. Another bravely jumped in to help, but in doing so put themselves at risk.
