Despite the chill, we have had another great week in school. Today, we celebrated our Stars of the Day, who were awarded for being ready to learn throughout the week – well done everyone!

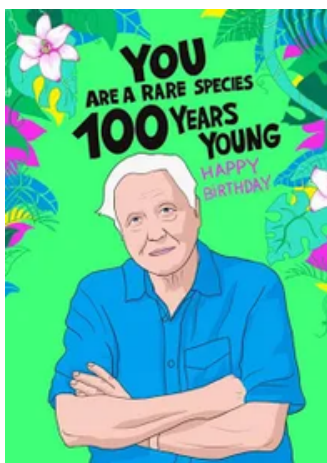
